Notes

The rota and liturgy will be kept open to review , reflecting any changes to Government or Church guidance and Advice received as the year goes on.

NO singing, may be music can be played by an organist or on a CD etc to gather, depart and reflection.

A new batch of shortened Holy Communion services, *Mass for Hard Times*, is being developed. A 30-40 minute service to allow time for private prayer, gathering and departing. This service sheet will remain in the pews and removed only if an occasional office is planned. Communion will be by bread alone. To vary the diet, "B" denotes BCP 1662 Service of Holy Communion. A new set of preprinted leaflets will be made available.

No Eucharistic Ministers, Processions, Crucifer, Choir etc. Collection to be a retiring one (see below). Someone to set up for Holy Communion would be appreciated.

Sides duties to be detailed - to include "track/trace card", sanitizer and seating monitoring.

Cash collections to be discouraged - replace by Standing Order . For limited cash collections, sort and bank irregularly (sorters to wear gloves, ideally leave collection counting to another day).

If lockdown resumes at any point - morning services at 9.30am and 11.00 will revert to Zoom services of Spiritual Communion at 10.30am.

Remembrance - No large gatherings - simple wreath laying with prayers of commendation and commitment with key players only. Maybe a service to be video'd for Facebook.

Lord's Alive - remains on line via Facebook

Advent Live - one service on Zoom.

The new Zoom based Evening Worship, at 5.30pm each Sunday as detailed, will build upon the successful Thursday Night Prayer and will be attractive to those that feel unable to gather for worship together in a church building or would like to explore a different form of worship at a different time. If social bubbles exist, perhaps if it is safe and appropriate to do so, people without internet access can gather with those that have. This will be a set service reviewed at Advent to determine its continuation or not.
