We can focus on the extraordinary truth that God is three persons and yet still one. God is above and beyond our attempts to explain or understand. Isn't that great? Our rational human explanations for God collapse when we are confronted by the truth that that God is three and God is one.

Nobody can ever understand God. God is a profound mystery and all human reasoning will always fail to encompass the glory of God.

So, let's stop worrying about our own lack of understanding and instead worship God the Father who showed his love for us in Jesus and lives in us today by the presence of the Holy Spirit.
